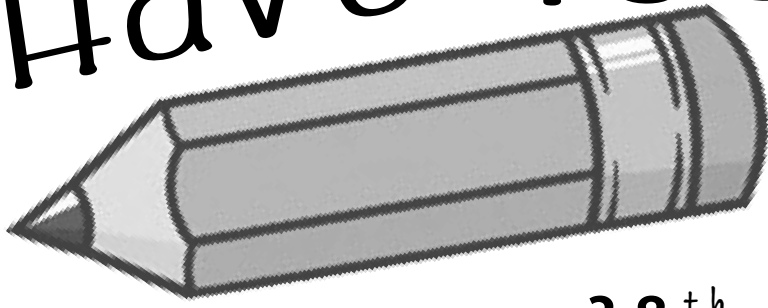

BE CREATIVE

Your story should be fictional and must be your very own. Don't retell the story in a movie or book. Topics are unlimited, but appropriate content is required. Excessive gore or violence is discouraged.

FOLLOW THE RULES

Maximum story length is 1,000 words. Winning stories will be printed in a spiral-bound book comprised of the authors' original work as submitted. Adults may type the story for a younger student, but story and words must be only that of the student. One student author is allowed per story. Stories will be reviewed with classroom teachers to ensure they are the students' work.

Your contest entry will be submitted digitally using the QR code to the right. The final story must be uploaded as a Google doc using Times New Roman font that is 12-point size and double-spaced.

AWARDS FOR EACH GRADE LEVEL

First place winners will receive a copy of Matt Hessel-Mial's published book. First, second and third place winners will receive prize packages, including bookstore gift cards. Other exceptional work will be awarded with Honorable mention.
